

MARS TRUST COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY ADVICE
FOR STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS

MARS Trust is planning to resume operating in schools in October 2020. The Trust has not delivered workshops in person since 18th March 2020 but has provided distance learning workshops for years 9-11 students.

MARS Trust has examined government advice on staying safe through this pandemic and we ask that you take time to read through this advice sheet and sign to say that you understand the information and will comply.

DO NOT ATTEND A MARS TRUST EVENT IF YOU HAVE:

- A fever of over 37.8°C
- A new persistent cough
- Loss of taste and /or smell
- Been contacted by Track and Trace as being at risk of infection
- Travelled from a country requiring quarantine in the last 14 days

IF ATTENDING A MARS TRUST EVENT PLEASE DO:

Travel to events alone in your car or wear a face covering on public transport and in all communal areas, or where social distancing of over 1 metre is not possible.

Sanitise your hands on entering the building, after touching surfaces that may carry the virus, and wash your hands when you return home.

Follow all the School Safety Guidance for each individual school you attend for all time spent within the school premises. This will be forwarded to you at least 3 days before the event.

Disinfect all teaching materials or store in a container that can be disinfected and stored to quarantine the contents.

Inform staff if you see any disregard for safety advice.
